Preamble

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 45 (2) of the Environmental Quality Act, 1974[Act 127], the Minister makes the following rules:

Rule 1. Citation, commencement and application.

- (1) These Rules may be cited as the **Environmental Quality (Compounding of Offences) Rules, 1978** and shall come into force on the 1st October 1978.
- (2) These Rules shall apply throughout Malaysia.

Rule 2. Sum to be collected and method of payment.

(1) The sum of money to be collected for compounding an offence shall not exceed two thousand ringgit.

- (2) Payment of the sum shall be made in cash, or by money order, postal order, cashier's order, banker's order, or banker's draft made payable to the Director-General of Environment and crossed "Account Payee Only".
- (3) Payment may be delivered personally to the person making the offer to compound, but, if sent by post, must be addressed to the Director-General of Environment, Government of Malaysia.
- (4) Every payment received shall be accounted for as money belonging to the Government of Malaysia and an official receipt shall be issued for it to the person to whom the offer to compound was made.

Rule 3. Form for offer to compound.

The form in the Schedule shall be used for making an offer to compound but may be modified as necessary.
